## LAUNCH READINESS

### ● Needs fixes before launch

Polished shell, three launch-stoppers we'd fix before you post the URL anywhere.

**None** / 10 LAUNCH READINESS SCORE

Sparkle Marketplace looks investor-ready in screenshots — then you click through. Dev shortcuts are still on the live URL, legal pages 404, the hero booking CTA fails, and mobile checkout is effectively broken. Clear the two critical items and the booking path before you share the link publicly.

**7 things your first users will hit** below, sorted by severity. Each one includes what we saw, why it matters to a real visitor, and a paste-ready fix prompt for Lovable.

## ● Stop — fix before any real users (2)

### FINDING 01 **Anyone can skip login — dev bypass on the live URL**

**What I saw.** Sparkle Marketplace's sign-in page ships with a "Dev Bypass (Skip Login)" button. One click opens a role picker and drops visitors into the app with no password.

**Why it matters.** We catch this on most Lovable apps that shipped before a final "remove dev UI" pass. On a marketplace, strangers can act as hosts or buyers.

Remove the "Dev Bypass (Skip Login)" button, the "Choose Your Dev Role" modal, and all "For development purposes only" copy from /auth. Only show these when `import.meta.env.DEV` is true. Never on the published `lovable.app` URL.

FINDING 02 **"Developer Tools" panel on the homepage customers see**

**What I saw.** After sign-in, Sparkle's homepage shows a "Developer Tools" card with "Seed Sample Data" and "Clear My Data" — visible on the public URL.

**Why it matters.** Paying users read this as "still in beta." It undercuts every polished pixel around it.

## ● Fix before launch (3)

### FINDING 03 Privacy and Terms links go to 404

**What I saw.** Sparkle's footer promises legal pages, but both privacy and terms URLs return the app's 404 screen.

**Why it matters.** Stripe and B2B buyers look for these before they trust you with money or data.

### FINDING 04 Hero "Quick Book" CTA dead-ends — zero bookable slots

**What I saw.** Sparkle's main "Quick Book" button opens a modal that says "No available slots found" and keeps "Book Now" disabled.

**Why it matters.** Every visitor who tries to book hits a wall — and most won't email you about it.

Fix Quick Book so available slots appear, OR hide Quick Book when no slots exist and show "No dates available yet, check back soon."

## FINDING 05 Booking modal breaks on mobile — CTA below the fold

**What I saw.** At phone width, Sparkle's Quick Book modal is taller than the screen. The time picker and "Book Now" button sit below the fold with no obvious scroll.

**Why it matters.** Most vibe-coded launches get more than half their traffic on phones.

## ● ● First users will notice this (2)

## FINDING 06 Listings show 4.5 stars with (0) reviews

**What I saw.** Cards display "4.5 (0)", a numeric rating with zero reviews.

**Why it matters.** Reads like seeded test data, which kills trust on a marketplace.

**FINDING 07 Every Sparkle listing says "Hosted by Local Host"**

**What I saw.** Every Sparkle Marketplace experience card shows "Hosted by Local Host" instead of a real host name.

**Why it matters.** Reads as placeholder data on a public marketplace.

**PASTE INTO LOVABLE TO FIX THIS**

Replace "Hosted by Local Host" with each experience's actual host display name from the database. If missing, show first name + last initial or hide the line.

**What to do next.** Start at the top. Paste each block into Lovable — read the "Paste this first" line, verify on your live URL, then move to the next finding.
